We are pleased to offer the following summer enrichment in Language Arts, Social Studies and Math which are designed to help students maintain the skills they acquired during the school year as well as prepare them for the new school year. The assignments are as follows:

Language Arts

Grades 9-11 have an *optional* enrichment reading activity developed by the Media specialist who will also direct voluntary book chats in September. Grades 9-11 have a list of grade level recommended novels that address different themes in the social/ emotional development of young teens and young adults.

Reading selections for the 9-11 grade enrichment will be posted on the school website.

Social Studies

Grades 9-11 each have an *optional* enrichment opportunity that engages them in research related to the course content in Social Studies. This assignment is linked from the school website.

AP

High School students taking AP classes in Language Arts and History have *required* summer assignments.

Although there are no specific reading assignments for twelfth grade, we strongly encourage all incoming seniors to read any of the selections for Language Arts because of the relevance and significance of the themes and topics.

Mathematics

Students will have the opportunity to practice math skills over the summer using www.ixl.com/signin/riverdell. Lists of individual math topics (by course) will be provided on the school's website. Although using IXL and the listed topics is *optional*, it is highly recommended that you practice to maintain math skills over the summer months. For any given topic, a student *does not* need to achieve a given score, but rather concentrate on maintaining their skills during the summer.
