



Dear Parent,

I am pleased to tell you that we will be using a website called IXL this year. IXL is a comprehensive math review site with an unlimited number of math practice questions— all of which are aligned to state standards. One of the best things about IXL is that your child can access it from home, so you have a chance to see your child's progress!

Each week, your child will be assigned specific skills that coincide with topics being taught in their Math class. ***In order to receive full credit for each topic assigned, students must earn a rating of “Excellent” or higher.***

Topics are designated by both letters and numbers. For example, if A.1, A.2, & A.3 were assigned on any given week, the highest possible score your child could earn would be a 3 (1 point for each topic assigned). In order to receive the 3 out of 3 possible points, your child must receive an excellent rating (or higher) on all sections assigned, in this case sections A.1, A.2, & A.3. However, if your child earned an “Excellent” rating on A.1, a “Good” rating on A.2, and an “Excellent” rating on A.3, his or her score would be a 2 out of 3 possible points because he or she did not earn a point for section A.2.
