Snow Shoveling Program

A COLLABORATIVE PROGRAM TO CONNECT OUR SENIOR RESIDENTS WITH OUR RIVER DELL STUDENTS

The program is intended to connect River Dell students with senior in the community who need snow removal.

- Students may earn a minimum of \$25 (to be worked out between residents)
- Senior Residents will receive a list of all registered students to make initial contact.
- Students will be expected to communicate with senior directly to coordinate the time and details.
- Student should provide their own shovels; salt must be provided by the senior resident,
- The student is not responsible for clearing off any vehicle due to potential property damage.
- Transportation is the responsibility of the student.
- Students are not permitted to enter the home.
- All participants must practice CDC safety guidelines: use masks, remain socially distant, and wash/sanitize hands.
